

Assessment Methods

Weekly assessments are designed to allow students to practise their reading, writing, listening and speaking skills while becoming the basis for ongoing personalised and specific training and feedback from teachers. Each week's grammar is also assessed to award students with certification that acknowledges their improvement and overall English level by completion of their course.
